



How many passengers are allowed to travel in a vehicle?

Buses

50% of licensed capacity

- In a 23-seater midibus:
15 passengers + 1 driver = 16 occupants

Taxis and minibuses

70% of licensed capacity

- In a 16-seater minibus:
10 passengers + 1 driver = 11 occupants

Public transport sedans (incl. e-hailing vehicles such as Uber)

50% of licensed capacity

- In an 11-seater minibus:
7 passengers + 1 driver = 8 occupants

- In a 5-seater public transport sedan:
1 driver + 1 passenger = 2 occupants

Private vehicles

60% of licensed capacity

- In a 5-seater private car:
1 driver + 2 passengers = 3 occupants

No standing is allowed on public transport vehicles
