Hand Washing



Washing hands with normal soap and running water works best. It works better than hand sanitizer as it destroys the virus and removes it from hands.

For people without access to piped or running water. If access to a shared tap is available, the following method can be used:

- 1. Make a hole in the lid of an empty plastic bottle (coke bottle, empty plastic water bottle, or similar).
- 2. Carefully fill the bottle with water.
- 3. Screw on the cap with a hole in it.
- 4. Wet hands with a little bit of the water.
- 5. Apply soap and rub all over your hands to create a foam/lather.
- 6. Use the remaining water to rinse through the hole in the lid of the bottle.
