BUSES



- 100% of licensed capacity on trips of less than 200km
- 70% of licensed capacity on trips of more than 200km

TAXIS AND MIDIBUSES



- 100% of licensed capacity on trips of less than 200km
- 70% of licensed capacity on trips of more than 200km

What safety measures do school transport operators have to take?



Regularly sanitise facilities with a sanitiser containing at least 60% alcohol



Make disinfection materials and procedures available



Sanitise vehicles, including handles, arm rests and handrails before and after every trip



Drivers must wear a mask



Make sure that vehicles are clean and tidy



Marshals at public transport facilities must wear masks

Keep yourself safe



Try to keep 1.5 metres away from the nearest person



If you are using public transport, open the windows



Try not to touch handles and rails. Clasp your hands together when you get on or off



When you greet, do not touch the other person



Wash your hands before and after travelling, and any time you can



Cough or sneeze into a bent elbow or into a tissue, and throw the tissue away
